



These effects were left in the home of her brother, Tsuruo ENTA, File 5606, at 424 Scott Road, Surrey.

Tsuruo did not declare the effects belonging to his sister specifically, but they were listed on an inventory submitted by the tenant of 424 Scott Road, and when these effects were liquidated the proceeds from the sale of all the effects were credited to Tsuruo ENTA, File 5606.


In a letter dated September 16th, 1945, Tsuruo ENTA requested that we transfer the proceeds from the sale of goods belonging to his sister from his own account to the account of Mary. This was done under date of October 9th, 1945.

3 Old beds, a range, 7 chairs and a cabinet were abandoned as valueless. The range was burnt out and the other articles were unsaleable. 1 table was abandoned. H.M. (home made)

The effects belonging to Mary ENTA were sold at Surrey auction on November 22, 1944, for the net sum of \$73.12, as per auction sheets on file. In addition a few effects were sold to the tenant Mr. P. O'Hara for the net sum of \$13.28. The total proceeds amounting to \$86.40 have now been credited to her account.







Dear Miss ETTA:

Your brother, Thomas ETTA, in a letter dated September 10th, 1945, requested us to forward you the proceeds from the sale of certain chattels removed from the farm at Scott and Serral Roads, Surrey, which had previously been credited to his account.

We note that these articles were declared by both you and your brother, but he informed us in his letter that these chattels were actually your property and asked us to transfer the credit from the sale of same to your account. All saleable goods declared by you have been sold, part at public auction, and the remainder independently appraised and sold to the tenant, the net proceeds being \$16.40. This amount has therefore been transferred to your account in accordance with the request made by your brother, and we enclose our cheque for same herewith. We also enclose copy of sales sheet for your information.

It would appear that we have accounted for all the property of every kind left by you in the protected area which vested in the Custodian and in order that you may confirm this and acknowledge the cheque, we are enclosing a stamped addressed envelope for convenience in replying.

Registered April 22/42. Evacuated April 25/42.

This evacuee (Taurus BNTA), leased his farm to Pat O'Hara and left his farm implements and household effects in the care of the latter. He did not leave an inventory, only declaring his effects in a general way. His sister, Mary BNTA, File 13982, declared having left her effects at the farm. However on January 16/43, a fire destroyed the chicken house and a quantity of equipment, which was not insured. An electric fan and a scale were left with J. F. McGlusky in North Vancouver, (memo of Jan. 31/44), the fan was shipped to BNTA and the scale is still in the care of Mr. McGlusky. The remaining chattels were liquidated on Nov. 22/44 at auction and by sale to the tenant. The proceeds were credited to Taurus BNTA, and the file of Mary BNTA has no credit for her effects. The 100 preserving bottles declared by Taurus BNTA were used by the tenant.

The declarant, Taurus BNTA, states "Farm implements left in the custody of P. O'Hara, lessee, including 1 spray pump, 2 duster pumps, also electric water pump and system, 100 preserving bottles. To be left in the custody of J. F. McGlusky - 1 electric fan and 1 scale.
