PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

RE: Kameichi YAMANE, Reg. No. 00580

This file reveals that YAMANE owned no real property in any protected area of B.C. and did not carry any Fire Insurance.

CHATELS: YAMANE made his declaration to the Custodian on Feb. 25/43 and was evacuated on March 31/42. He declared no chattels and neither did his wife, File 10694, and none were found by the Custodian belonging to either of them.

SPECIFIED ARTICLES: The R.C.M.P. seized a radio and camera belonging to Mr. YAMANE on Feb. 23/42. These were handed over to the Custodian on Jan. 27/44. The radio was sold at auction for the net sum of \$57.51 and this sum credited to his account with the Custodian. The camera is still in our warehouse. *mailed July 22, 1947*

MONEYS RECEIVABLE: The account of YAMANE was credited with the sum of \$4.08, representing a refund of 1% wage deductions for the first six months of 1941. This money was remitted to him on March 31/43.

VICTORY BOND: He declared a \$100.00 Victory Bond. This was not brought under the control of the Custodian.

LIFE INSURANCE: He also declared an insurance policy with the Sun Life Assurance Co. in the sum of \$1000.00. This was not brought under the control of the Custodian.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.





Your file has been reviewed and the following noted.

When you made your declaration to the Custodian on February 25th, 1943, you declared no chattels belonging to you were left in the protected area and none were found.

You surrendered a radio and a camera to the R.C.M.P. The radio was sold at auction for the net sum of \$57.51, and this amount credited to your account with the Custodian. Your camera is in storage in our warehouse.

We recovered from the Provincial Collector the sum of \$4.08 in your favour, representing 15 tax refund on your wages for the first six months of 1941. This amount was remitted to you on March 31st, 1943.

You declared a \$100.00 Victory bond and a life insurance policy in the sum of \$1000.00 with the Sun Life Assurance Co. These did not come under the control of the Custodian.

It would appear that we have accounted for all the property of every kind left by you in the protected area which vested in the Custodian and in order that you may confirm this, we are enclosing a stamped addressed envelope for convenience in replying.
