GENERAL SUMMARY

Re: Ichijiro OHASHI, Deceased.

Ichijiro Ohashi died on October 21, 1941. He was a widower at the time of his death and is survived by one son, Kazuo, file #12264, who has now returned to Japan; one married daughter, Fumiko, who we are unable to trace, and one minor daughter, Yoshiko, who is in Japan.

In July, 1945, the sum of \$3.00 was received for the account of the deceased, being refund of security deposit for light. This sum was transferred to the account of Dr. C. G. Hori, Internee File #213, on Sept. 13, 1945, to apply on a claim of \$35.00 against the deceased as shown on the list of Accounts Receivable filed on behalf of Dr. Hori by P. S. Ross and Sons. Kazuo Ohashi was advised of this payment.

On December 12, 1945, the sum of \$21.86, being balance of deceased's account in the Bank of Montreal, Main and Hastings Branch, which had been inactive since 1940, was forwarded to this office and credited to his account. These funds are today being transferred to the account of Dr. C. G. Hori to apply on his account. This action is taken in view of the fact that it is impossible to contact the heirs to obtain their approval and, as the claim was taken from the doctor's books by P. S. Ross and Sons, it is quite probable that it is correct.

Another claim of \$3.07 by Kijujiro Tanaka is recorded but as it is not definitely known that this claim is against the deceased and as it is not possible to have it acknowledged, we are taking no action in this regard.
