
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Life Insurance:

Mr. Tanaka declared "Crown Life Insurance" and "Prudential Insurance" in his JP form signed under date of March 14, 1943. There is no reference, other than in the JP Form, to the Prudential Insurance in this file, but under date of November 24, 1945, the Crown Life Insurance advised that they had two policies on which Mr. and Mrs. Tanaka their money returned to them. The Crown Life stated that Policy No. 264,016 lapsed on Jan. 28/45 but that there was a cash surrender value of \$31.27 under Policy 272,650 as at November 26th, 1945. The Custodian advised the Crown Life that he had no objection to their paying the surrender value direct to the Japanese.

NO OTHER PROPERTY OF ANY KIND WHATSOEVER BELONGING TO THE ABOVE JAPANESE PERSON IS REVEALED ON THIS FILE.
