With further reference to the four (4) boxes of tools which you declared on April 28th, 1942, as your property, we note you now state they are actually the property of Toshio NAKAGARA.

On rechecking all carpenter tools sold, we find this comes to a total of \$110.30. You have at the present time \$59.08 standing to your credit, which would make you responsible to Mr. NAKAGARA in the amount of \$51.22, already paid to you by this office.

Mr. NAKAGARA certified that he had no property of any kind in the protected area of British Columbia, and must now look to you for this difference. Before this money can be released to Mr. NAKAGARA, a complete review of your file is necessary and you will hear from us in due course.
