




Please note that the above Japanese has been repatriated to Japan. The following is the status of his account with this Department, covering the repatriation transactions:

CHATELS:

The above, who registered with the Custodian on April 20th, 1943, signed a yellow "No property" card stating that he had no property of any kind whatsoever in any protected area of British Columbia. However in a letter dated March 20th, 1945, he advised us that he had left some books at 802 East Hastings St. These books were recovered but were principally cheap Japanese novels having no value whatsoever. The books were removed to Custodian warehouse and discarded as having no sale value.

The file reveals the above owned no specified articles.

ACCOUNTS RECEIVABLE:

The above purchased some goods from Mr. J. W. Anderson and paid him the sum of \$7.75 for same. Receipt for this is on file. However Mr. Anderson just delivered goods to MURAKUBO to the value of \$1.55, and failed to return the balance of the money. We have written to Mr. Anderson re this refund of \$5.95 several times but he has never replied to our letters.

INCOME TAX REFUND:

We received the sum of \$16.75 from the Inspector of Income Tax in favour of the above, being repayment of overpayment of income tax for 1942. This cheque was remitted to MURAKUBO on April 26/45.

REFUND:

We received the sum of \$1.01 from the B.C. Electric Railway Co. in favour of the above, being a refund of security deposit for light. This was credited to the account of the above and is his entire credit balance with the Custodian.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.

We have reviewed your file from which we note you registered with the Custodian on April 20th, 1943, at which time you declared no assets or liabilities. Subsequently we recovered the sum of \$16.75, representing a refund of over payment in your 1942 income tax, and this amount was remitted to you on April 26th, 1945.
