herewith enclose Money Order for \$4.15 in payment
of my account with the Vancouver General Hospital.

Regarding the second claim of Mrs Toyotaro
(Sami) Uyeda, I wish to explain that as a Gardener
with men working for me in Vancouver, I had contracts
with various householders from year to year. Work
that I was to do in the Spring of 1942, to fulfill
a contract, would have made it possible for me to
settle the balance of wages owing to my workmen in
full, but as I was called to a Road Camp in March
of that year, I was not able to meet my obligations,
and therefore this balance is outstanding. I do not
think I shall be able to pay this until the war is
over, but believe Mr Uyeda understands this.
