MEMORANDUM - MR. F. G. SHEARS

This man has sent down a Policy Discharge Form from Tashiro, through Mr. Good, in order that the Custodian may assist him to obtain cash proceeds from his insurance policy.

This man appears to be alone in Canada, the beneficiary under the policy being Yoru, his wife, who, together with all his children, is reported as being in Japan.

Would you please sign for the Enemy beneficiary? regarding possible obligations left in Canada, this man's file indicates that he guaranteed payment of a hospital bill for his father, who died in St. Joseph's Hospital (T. B. Hall) on February 13, 1936. Apparently Kohsiji Horii promised to pay \$3.00 per month on a bill of \$3,483.00. During this period he has paid a total of \$13.25 on account. I presume that under the circumstances, we will not be interested in suggesting that any part of these proceeds be applied to this account.

Re: Policy No. 195,274.

We wish to acknowledge your letter requesting the cash surrender value of your policy rather than the Paid-Up value for which you have already arranged.

If you will recall from our previous correspondence, unless we can have the signature of your wife who is a preferred beneficiary or if you can make a change to either your parents or children who are also in the preferred class and who might be available to sign the discharge form, the surrender cannot be granted to you. Our authority for this is the Canadian Life Insurance Act which governs the dealings of all Canadian life insurance companies with their policyholders. We recall that we pointed this out to you previously and that you were unable to supply us with the necessary signature. This same ruling will, therefore, apply unless your circumstances have altered.

We very much regret that we cannot grant you your request and would suggest that you proceed with the change to Paid-Up insurance which is permitted on your signature alone. If you wish to do this will you please let us know.


