The above-numbered policy has been reported on Form 'D' on the basis that the assured is a resident of Japan. The basis for the report was a communication from our Vancouver Branch Office in which it was stated that a representative of the Company had informed them of the assured's return to Japan.

The information given to us in that memo now appears to be incorrect. We have just received from our Vancouver Branch a request for the Cash Surrender Value of this policy, which request has been signed by the assured. The Branch state that the representative who previously informed them the assured was in Japan now has told them that he is still in Canada and that he was in error in stating that the assured was in Japan. The information that he had received referred to the assured's brother, who is not a policyholder of our Company. The present address of our assured is said to be 148 Columbia St., New Westminster, B.C.

The Branch Office have asked us to send the settlement cheque for the cash value to them by Air Mail. Will you, therefore, kindly let us


The Sun Life Assurance Company of Canada has reported Policy No. 854,257, for \$1,000.00, issued in favour of Minoru Kadota.

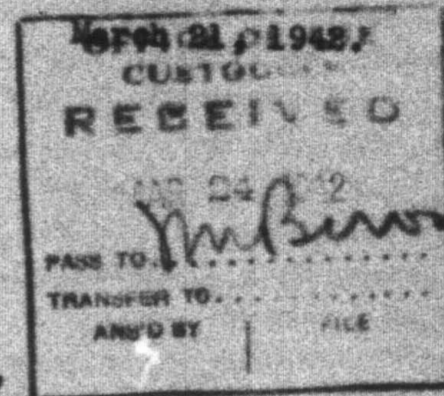
