This 29-year old Para Band, a Japanese National, from Port Alice, B. C., signed a Custodian "JP" declaration form on September 14th, 1945.

He was evacuated on March 10th, 1942.

Information from R.C.M.P. reports him to be Single and his widowed Mother to be living in Japan.

The following is a summary of the contents of this file as disclosed by a review made today.

Accounts Receivable: A debt of \$600.00 declared (Sept. 14, 1945) to be owed by Kinaku NISHIMOTO, Reg. No. 12884 (File 3955) was collected by this office and credited to Evacuee's account.

Bank Accounts: No action was taken by this office with regard to a bank balance of \$600.00 (name and address of bank not stated). X


Life Insurance: None.

We are in receipt of your letter of the 1st instant asking us to assist you in collecting the sum of \$600.00 from Mr. KISAKU NISHIMOTO.

Reviewing your file we find that on the 6/3/1943, 10/4/1943, 9/7/1943, 1/9/1943 and 4/10/1943 we wrote you requesting you to complete and return to us certain forms enabling you to declare your assets and liabilities but that in spite of this effort in your interest you failed to comply with our request. Consequently we have no record of the state of your affairs at the time of your evacuation.

At this late date we are not prepared to accept responsibility for the care and protection of assets, if any, left in this district, and the completion and return by you of the forms already sent you is a necessary preliminary to any action being taken by this office.

A review of your file shows that in spite of numerous requests you failed to complete the Custodian "JP" declaration form or "No Property" card until the 14th September, 1945, and that the only items declared then were a debt of \$600.00 owed to you by Kisaku NISHIMOTO, Reg. No. 12884 (File 3955), and a Bank Account of \$600.00. Name and address of the Bank was not given and as our records are incomplete without this information we would ask you to supply it.

The debt mentioned above was collected by this office and credited to your account, being the only item shown therein. In compliance with your request, therefore, we enclose our cheque in your favour for \$600.00, leaving no balance in your account, which will therefore be closed.
