Later the premises were condemned by the Sanitary Inspector of that area and the chattels were removed to Warehouse at 992 Powell St. Vancouver, B.C. and sold, the proceeds being credited to your account on our books.

As your declaration and that of Hoshino dealt with the chattels, in part, in a general way, we have been unable to set apart the proceeds that belong to you and those that belong to Hoshino.
