Mr. Sugie was written on three separate occasions in connection with settlement of these claims but no reply has been received by the Custodian. Therefore, in our last letter dated May 8th, 1947, we advised Mr. Sugie that in the absence of a reply to our letter by May 22nd, 1947, to the contrary we would assume that the above money was owed by him and would proceed to apply the small credit of \$8.33 in his account on these debts.

Accordingly, in the absence of a reply we have applied on a pro rata basis the above credit of \$8.33 on the claims of the Union Fish Company Limited and Sakubai Izukawa as of this date, and a letter has gone forward to Mr. Sugie today advising him of our action in connection with his debts.
