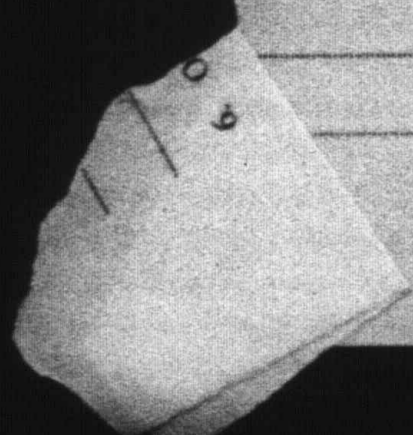

In reply to your letter of the 9th instant with reference to effects said to be stored with Dr. Bede Harrison, 4426 Cartier Street, Vancouver.


Reference to our file fails to disclose any declaration regarding these chattels. Neither Mr. Konishi or Dr. Harrison complied with Custodian requirements. It will be in order to release these goods, but in view of the circumstances, we presume the R. C. M. P. might wish to be satisfied that the packages do not contain items of interest to them, or any prohibited articles.

With reference to the radio said to belong to Mr. Konishi's sister. According to Mr. Konishi's registration, he has a father living, a mother deceased, but no sister.

We would require further particulars with the correct name of the owner before release can be granted.

Has the R. C. M. P. been duly advised that this prohibited article was held by a private party instead of being surrendered to them?

Your file 14189, letter August 10th:

The R.C.M.P. are not interested in examining the contents of the goods of the above left with Dr. Bede Harrison, 4426 Cartier St.

Neither are they making any issue of the fact that this man left the radio which he claims belonged to his sister with Dr. Harrison. The Orders-in-Council issued early in 1942 left a loophole for all Japanese to dispose of their radios in any manner they saw fit and they were clear of the law if the radios were not in their possession. Later on, instructions were given that they should turn their radios in to the R.C.M.P. Mrs. Harrison says KONISHI had a sister. The R.C.M.P. records do not give such information in the case of adults. If you do not wish to turn the radio over to us, presume you will arrange to take delivery of it yourself. Please advise.
