SUMMARY of LIABILITIES

The above Japanese person did not declare any debts on his JP Form which we received in May 1943, neither signed nor dated. However, a review of this file reveals the following claims against the above Evacuee:

Feb. 27, 1943	Nasajiro KIMURA	\$135.00
Sept. 19, 1942	Sakubei ISHIZAWA	40.60
Nov. 6, 1942	Vancouver General Hospital (a/s of Mrs. Omoto)	99.50

We wrote to Mr. Omoto on March 22, 1944 and again on May 23, 1944 respecting these debts but received no reply. We then wrote to the Department of Labour, Japanese Division, asking that they have their representative interview him concerning the above-mentioned claims against him. On November 8th, 1944, we received a report from the Department of Labour, Japanese Division, advising that they had interviewed this Evacuee and that he had apologized for not replying to our letters, but he confirmed these debts and stated he would endeavor to pay off to the best of his ability the above three debts as soon as he was again earning a normal wage.

Accordingly, on November 13th, 1944 we sent a copy of the Department of Labour's report to each of the three creditors, advising them that we had insufficient funds to settle their claims and therefore could not assist further in collecting the amounts owing. At this time we gave each of the creditors the address of the above Evacuee in case they wished to contact him direct.

NO FURTHER ACTION REGARDING THE ABOVE CLAIMS TAKEN BY THE CUSTODIAN.
