Carlo Louisia BOT TOSHIO HIROSAVA Your communication of the 26th ult. addressed to the Secretary of State, Ottown, has been transferred to this office for attention. The property is situate beyond the protected area and the matter does not come within the Regulations Respecting Trading With The Enemy (1939), supowering the Custodian to take over the management of enemy assets. On the 26th February, 1942, Order in Council No. 1457 was passed to regulate the acquisition of land and any interest therein by parsons of the Japanese race, and no such person is permitted to acquire or hold land or growing crops following the passing of the Order in Council. Sub Section 44 of Clause 398, however, provides that the Minister of Justice may, if it ears to him to be in the public interest to do so, grant a license to a person of the Japanese race to acquire and hold land or growing crops, and it would therefore be necessary for you to economicate with the Minister of Justice in this regard. It might be helpful to you to know that the Department has ruled that the license would not be so granted without the approval of the Attorney General of British Columbia, It is therefore suggested that you present the facts to Honorable R.L.
