



Chattels: Although the above Evacuee was written on three separate occasions in an effort to obtain signed copies of our JP form, no reply was received and no JP forms appear on this file. However, a review of this file reveals that Mr. Endo had four pictures and a box of kitchenware, which articles were sold at Vancouver Auction 44 on April 25th, 1945, the net proceeds in the amount of .35¢ being credited to his account.

Life Insurance: This file also reveals a Manufacturers Life Insurance Policy, No. 444,359 in the above Japanese person's name, but at no time was this policy under the control of the Custodian.




