This Japanese was a minor and did not register with the Custodian as she was in the Provincial T.B. Hospital. She died in the New Denver Sanitorium on the 22nd January, 1945, at the age of 18.

Referring to your letter of February 7th, we beg to advise that we have no assets registered in the name of the above party but have a claim by the Provincial Board of Health under date of April 16, 1943 for \$3,024.00.

Her father, Torakichi ISOSHIMA, owned property at Maple Ridge, which was sold and we have \$1,022.41 to his credit, but there are claims by the Provincial T. B. Unit for \$7,413.00 against him (The above \$3,024.00 is included in this amount). As the deceased daughter was not a minor, there is no legal claim against the father unless he contracted for the funeral, but you might write him to see if he will pay the cost of his daughter's burial.
