This camera is still in our warehouse and we have written to his mother asking if she wishes this camera shipped to her.

There is a claim on file against him by the Provincial Board of Health, Tuberculosis Division, in the sum of \$1230.00.

No property other than the camera has been found belonging to George OYAMA.

Dear Sir: Re: George OYAMA, #15949, Dec'd.


