Dear Sir:

Referring to your letter of January 19th stating that there were no articles belonging to us in your custody, there is no indication that Mr. Arai removed our belongings with his when he had his shipped. We correspond with the Arai family frequently but they have not mentioned anything about the subject.

In 1943 when we were residing in Westbank, I was requested to fill out a form regarding belongings left at Mr. Arai's premises; therefore, I believe you have investigated same and some of your officials must have removed articles from the above mentioned premises.

I shall, however, obtain Mrs. Reid's address from Mr. Arai and inquire about our belongings. We are in need of them now as they are impossible to purchase.

Please note that our address is now Vernon, B. C. as indicated above.

With reference to Custodian release signed by you December 8th, 1944, calling for kitchen utensils, books and clothing, this property as you are aware was operated by Mr. Kozo Arai.
