GENERAL SUMMARY

Re: NURI, Kenzo.- Reg. No. 00005.

The above was evacuated on February 23, 1942 and made a declaration to the Custodian, from Kelowna on April 19, 1943.

He declared a three-quarter size bedstead with spring and mattress and a full size trunk containing books and clothing, stored at 406 Alexander Street.

Mr. Spain, of the Custodian's Office, on investigation found the bed to be of no value and consequently it was abandoned.

The trunk was discovered to have been opened; a few remnants of clothing and books and papers, as well as a bayonet were found. The Bayonet was removed to the office and is in the care of the Internee Department. The trunk was removed to 604 East Cordova and sold by auction Vancouver 56 for the net sum of \$2.44. There is no record of what became of the contents of the trunk said to be of little value but it is possible that they are stored at 604 East Cordova with other personal goods.

The proceeds of the sale of the Trunk are being remitted to Kenzo NURI on this date.

There is no evidence of any other property.

This summary is certified to be in accordance with the information on file.

The above noted person declared 1 bed and 1 trunk.

The bed was discovered but proved to be of no value and was abandoned.

The trunk was discovered. It was found open when examined by the writer. It contained a few remnants of clothing and books and papers. The contents had little value.

A bayonet was removed from the trunk, and being a prohibited article, same was turned in to the legal department to be put in the cabinet there where such articles are being retained.

The trunk was moved to storage at 604 East Cordova Street to be kept there among personal baggage.
