
Please note that the above Japanese has been repatriated to Japan. The following is the status of his account with this Department, covering the repatriation transactions:

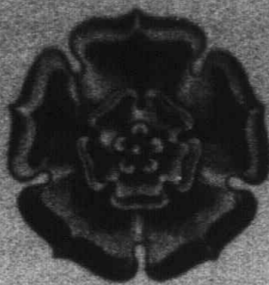

The above party, together with his wife, Sakiye Minate, are the registered holders of ten of our 15-year plan endowment instalment shares. These shares presently have a cash withdrawal value of \$418.80 and Mr. Minate has requested the cash withdrawal value of these shares. He has returned the share certificate to us and has also provided us with our form of receipt in full settlement of all claims on the share certificate.

The Savings & Loan Association Act requires that the cash withdrawal form must be signed in the same manner as the share certificate is made out but Mr. Minate advises us today, his wife, Sakiye Minate, is now living in Japan and cannot sign the document. He also advises that he is leaving Raymond, Alberta on May 25 and we are assuming that he, too, is en route to Japan.

In a conversation with a member of your staff today, he recommended that we deliver our cheque to the Custodian of Enemy Property instead of the standard practice of forwarding this cheque to the registered owner and that your office would protect us by seeing that the disbursement of this cheque would be within the requirements of the Act under which this Association operates. We are today notifying Mr. Minate of this action and suggesting that he contact your Department after his arrival in Vancouver on May 26th.

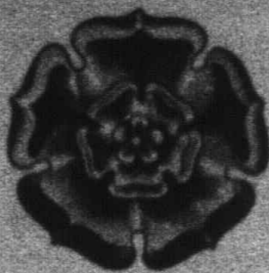
