Referred mealister Attention to be Mariator, Spiles Sept. Cent Lement Re: Cak. Blabour. Your File Humber 14596. Referring to yours of 20ml inst., so the claim made by the above-rty for the sum of \$241.00 for judgment, plus costs, I wish to name party for the sur interm you as follows: I do not know the said Mr. Blakeney, but am familiar with the case which happened some thirteen years' ago. I had been employed by Mr. Scientre MISHIMIRA of Michel Spray Conpany, Vancouver, B. C., some thirteen years ago at the salary of \$60,00 a north. Oring to the financial conditions of this Company, syealf and for other Japanese employees and an occidental couple were paid only half month's salary for two norths of employment. This occidental couple, the man working as salamen and wife as typist, filed a suit against hr. Richimura for their unpuid salaries, and hr. Richimura lost the case. Mr. Richimura had some years ago left for Japan, and is now deceased. At that time claims were made against myself and other Japanese amployees as being partners of Mr. Nishimure, and, therefore, liable for sourt expenses, but as mentioned before, since we were only employed by Mr. Nishimure, this claim against us was dropped. Three years after court proceeding, a lawyer approached no again on this matter, but with the same result, therefore, I see no reason why this claim should be filed against no at this time. I would appreciate your stressing to Mr. Blekensy the fact that I was only an employee and not the partner of the Bickimum. I am enclosing one copy only of your Registration form since I do put in the not own any roal asset and all personal proporties have been registered by my wife prior to evacuation.
