PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

RE: Takejiro WAKABAYASHI, Reg. No. 00720

This file reveals that WAKABAYASHI owned no real property in any protected area of B.C. and did not carry any Fire Insurance.

CHATELS:

Mr. WAKABAYASHI made his declaration to the Custodian on Sept. 15/43 and was evacuated on March 31/42.

He declared the following: "I have noting important to fill in this form except a few junks of odds and ends at the First Ave. Buddhist Church.

A memo to file dated Jan. 30/43 states that one large box of kitchen utensils was marked with the name of "T. WAKABAYASHI". There is no evidence on file that this box was moved to auction from 1684 West 1st Ave. and no indication on the file as to what became of it. I have checked the file of his wife and children but there are no chattels declared or sold on any of them. However since WAKABAYASHI himself called it junk, it is quite possible that none of the articles were saleable and may have been discarded.

MONEYS RECEIVABLE:

His account was credited with the sum of \$3.61 being a refund of 1% waged deductions for first six months of 1941. This sum was remitted to him on Sept. 24/43.

In July, 1945, his account was credited with the sum of \$1.38, being a refund of security deposit for light from the B.C.E.R. This is his only credit with the Custodian.

Since the cheque for \$3.61 was sent to WAKABAYASHI, a claim has been filed against him by T. MAIKAWA STORES LTD. for \$11.15. I am therefore writing him today regarding this debt, and his small credit of \$1.38 will be held until we receive his reply.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.
