
Please note that the above has been repatriated to Japan. At the time of repatriation, the following transactions took place:

Dear Sir:

Enclosed herewith is Custodian cheque in the amount of \$4.97, representing all funds standing to your credit with this office.

Your file has been reviewed and it is noted that you did not sign a declaration to the Custodian in regard to your property. Therefore the only information on record in connection with your affairs has been supplied from other sources.

Information on your file indicates that a shipment, consisting of a sewing machine, two boxes and two men's suits, was made to you in May, 1943, by the British Columbia Security Commission.

Your camera was reported to this office by the Royal Canadian Mounted Police. This camera was shipped to you by Canadian Pacific Express on October 3rd, and should now be in your hands. The cost of shipping was 72 cents, leaving a balance of 29 cents to be returned to you from the sum of \$1.00, which you sent to this office to cover this cost. This sum is included in the cheque enclosed herewith.

The Provincial Collector, Vancouver, paid in to this office the sum of \$4.68 on your behalf. This sum represented refund of one per cent wage deductions for the first six months of 1941, and was credited to your account.

It is felt that we have accounted for all property of every kind left by you in the protected area which vested in the Custodian, and in order that you may confirm this and acknowledge receipt of the enclosed cheque and the camera which was expressed to you, we attach a stamped, addressed envelope for your convenience in replying.

This man was evacuated on May 31, 1942. A declaration to the Custodian, dated July 27, 1943, is on his file, but it carries instead of a signature a pencilled notation "will not sign."

Effects: Under date of May 5, 1943, is a copy of letter from the British Columbia Security Commission to Richmond Transfer asking that a sewing machine, a box of dishes, 2 men's suits and a box of books be picked up at 524 West 12th Avenue, Vancouver, the home of Mr. Campbell, and shipped to this Japanese at New Denver, at the Commission's expense.

Camera: The camera described in Specified Articles Memorandum was seized by the Royal Canadian Mounted Police, at New Denver, on March 30, 1943, after this man's permit to take pictures was revoked.

Money
Owing
to Him: Refund of 1 per cent wage deductions for first six months of 1941 received from the Provincial Collector, Vancouver, in the amount of \$4.68, was credited to this man's account.
