Taken from B. C. Packers' letter of April 26th, 1943.
Original on file 10221.

"I mentioned to you on several occasions the two floats lying in Reifel's Slough belonging to K. Teraguchi, one float 75' x 12', and the other 50' x 12'. These floats are not in very good shape and will require certain repairs. For the two floats we are prepared to pay you a rental of \$15.00 per year, or on a purchase basis, pay you the sum of \$50.00 for the two floats. Thanking you for your consideration in the above."

With reference to yours of April 26th, we cannot trace the above Japanese on our records but have asked Mr. Robinson to examine the floats and fix up rental on the basis suggested by you pending a decision as to whether a sale can be made.

We take this opportunity of passing on to you a request we have received from the tenant of Quo's scow-house that the floats thereto be removed as soon as possible. If you could let us have the purchase price of these floats fairly promptly, we should also be grateful as we have a disbursement to make from these funds to the tenant of the scow-house for his care of these floats.

The B. C. Packers have asked us about two floats lying in Reifel's slough belonging to the above Japanese, one 75' x 12' and the other 50' x 12'. As it is Mr. Clugston who asked me about these, I think they are probably near the Celtic Cannery. They offer rent of \$15.00 per year for these floats or \$50.00 outright purchase. Would you have a look at them and give me your recommendations? We have no objection to your renting them straight away, but please do not close any sale without reference to this office.

I should mention that this Japanese is not registered and we are unable to trace if these floats do actually belong to him.
