With reference to your letter of January 17, 1947, we would advise that, upon inquiring of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police about firearms surrendered by your grandfather, Bunichi HAMADE, the police turned over to this office the Winchester rifle, which we have sold. We have no knowledge of other firearms.

In regard to the 22 gauge rifle and shot gun mentioned in your letter, we would be pleased to have more information in connection with these so that we can take the matter up with the Royal Canadian Mounted Police. If you do not have details in regard to these firearms, possibly your grandfather will be in a position to supply these.

When we have received sufficient information we will follow this matter up on behalf of Mr. Bunichi HAMADE.
