The radio about which you inquired in your letter of March 24th is, no doubt, the one that was turned over to the police by your mother. This radio is unsold, and is being held to give you an opportunity to arrange for shipment if you wish to have the radio shipped.

Our records show this radio to be the property of your mother. In order to have it shipped to you, it will be necessary for your mother to advise that the radio is actually your property, or that she wishes the radio shipped to you.

Shipment is made through the British Columbia Security Commission, and packing and shipping charges are paid by the owner.
