

GENERAL SUNMARY Tasajiro NAKAYA Reg. No. 10576 File No. 14584 Pasajiro NAKAYA died at Sandon, B. C. on Merch 31, 1943. he had not registered with the Custodian and nothing is known of his assets. The deceased was a widower and had no living children of which we have knowledge. The B. C. Security Commission filed a claim against the estate of the deceased for recovery of the sum of \$80.00 to cover cost of his burial. They were advised by this office that, as this Japanese had no registered with the Custodian, we knew nothing of his assets. This summary is certified to be in accordance with information on file.
