Tasajiro NAKAYA died at Sandon, B. C. on March 31, 1943. He had not registered with the Custodian and nothing is known of his assets. The deceased was a widower and had no living children of which we have knowledge.

The B. C. Security Commission filed a claim against the estate of the deceased for recovery of the sum of \$80.00 to cover cost of his burial. They were advised by this office that, as this Japanese had no registered with the Custodian, we knew nothing of his assets.

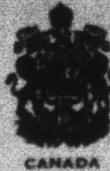
