This file reveals that Chuzo FURUKAWA owned no real property in any protected area of B.C. and did not carry any Fire Insurance.

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CHATELS: FURUKAWA did not register with the Custodian. He was evacuated on March 10/42. His wife declared the chattels and these are dealt with on her file, #5477.

SPECIFIED ARTICLES: A Victor radio was surrendered to the R.C.M.P. in the name of Chuzo FURUKAWA on March 10/42. It was handed over to the Custodian on Jan. 27/47 and sold at auction for the net sum of \$22.94 and this sum credited to the account of FURUKAWA.


MONEYS RECEIVABLE: In July, 1945, the account of FURUKAWA was credited with the sum of \$2.73, being a refund of security deposit for light from the B.C.E.R.
