GENERAL SUMMARY

Re: Seiji INOUE, Reg. No. 00330

This man operated a garage & gas station and lived at 504 Alexander St., Vancouver, prior to his evacuation. He was evacuated on March 4, 1942, but did not sign a declaration to the Custodian until September 8, 1943. His wife, File 10592, was evacuated on June 16, 1942, and signed a declaration on June 12, 1942.

Chattels: In his declaration, Seiji INOUE reported ownership of 1 trunk, 1 Box, 1 chesterfield, 1 table, 1 looking glass, stored by Sogo OMURA, Hammond, B.C. The name most closely resembling this that we have in our records is Shogo OMURA, Port Hammond, B.C., File 8698. A large quantity of goods were found at the home of Shogo OMURA, and some of these were sold by the Custodian. In March 14, 1944, OMURA visited Port Hammond, and at that time he signed a statement to the Custodian advising that all his personal property had been disposed of by himself and that he no longer had anything in the protected area for which the Custodian need care. Previously shipments had been made from the OMURA house. It would seem that if this is the place where INOUE's goods were left, these were disposed of by OMURA probably with the consent of INOUE. Nothing identified as INOUE's property was found in this house.

INOUE declared 2 boxes of vessels stored with Mrs. Harrison, 2275 McGill St., Vancouver, B. C. On November 8, 1943, 2 cases of household goods were shipped from 2275 McGill St. to INOUE at Kelowna. INOUE sent to Mrs. Harrison \$6.00 to pay shipping costs. This sum was turned over to the Custodian who paid the costs amounting to \$4.48. The balance of \$1.52 was remitted to INOUE on May 21, 1947.

Mrs. INOUE had declared on June 12, 1942, that she had sold the furniture.

INOUE also declared ownership of one dog, one cat and one goat, but did not state where these were to be found. No action was taken in regard to these animals.

INOUE declared a Victory Bond \$250.00, a bank account of \$1,437.40 and life insurance valued at \$1,000.00. He gave no further information regarding these, and these items were not brought under the control of the Custodian.

The sum of \$30.00 received as refund of B.C. Electric Railway Co. security deposit for light was credited to the account of INOUE, and on May 21, 1947, this money was remitted to him.

This file reveals no other property. We have no record of a motor-vehicle belonging to INOUE.
