This small sum is being remitted to Mr. Tatebe as per our requisition on file dated October 24, 1946.

Although not declared to the Custodian by the above Japanese, correspondence on file reveals that the wife of this Japanese, Ume TATEBE (file 10617) had a Prudential Insurance Policy, No. 401821047, beneficiary being Tahei TATEBE. These Japanese asked for the cash surrender of this policy in March of this year but according to information on the bottom of our letter of March 12th on file they changed their minds and cancelled their application for the cash surrender of the above policy.

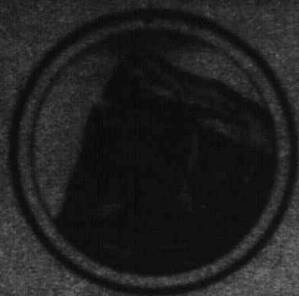
