GENERAL SUMMARY

Re: TOMA, Fujima Yosaku (Mr.) - Reg. No. 00122.

The above did not declare any property of any kind. He was evacuated from the protected area March 21, 1942.

However, 2 cartons marked with his name were moved from 391 Powell Street, Victory Rooms, where he formerly lived, to 154 West 5th Avenue. From information supplied by Mr. Wills it would appear that the place of storage was broken into and ransacked and that no trace of the cartons could be found.

This file reveals no other property of any kind, nor does it reveal any liabilities.

The above summary is certified to be in accordance with the information on file.

MEMORANDUM

371 Powell St., Yonkers, N.Y.

A check of the files of persons who had left goods at the above address, has been made from a list supplied by Mr. Wills. This list comprised items found on the chattels when they were removed to 154 West 9th Avenue, in June 1943.

A carton and skis were sold by auction for Yoshitaro HARAGUCHI and a trunk belonging to MATSUSHITA, Shige, Int. 1013 shipped to him. Nothing else can be accounted for and Mr. Wills advises that the chattels were thoroughly searched in the Victory Rooms and again at 154 West 9th.

There is nothing in the names of any of the former tenants stored at 601 East Cordova Street.
