PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

This file reveals that Mrs. YAMAMOTO owned no real property in any protected area of B.C. and did not carry any Fire Insurance.

CHATELS:

Mrs. YAMAMOTO did not register with the Custodian until Oct. 6/43. She was evacuated on April 15/42. Mr. Fumio YAMAMOTO did not register with the Custodian.

Mrs. YAMAMOTO declared chattels as shown on Schedule on file, left at 2005 W. 5th Ave. Mrs. Tomizo ONODERA, File 9952, declared that some chattels belonging to Mr. Fumio YAMAMOTO were stored with her chattels at 2013 W. 5th Ave. These two lists of chattels are identical except that Mrs. ONODERA lists two articles not listed by Mrs. YAMAMOTO. It is quite likely that Mrs. YAMAMOTO left her chattels in care of Mrs. ONODERA who was not evacuated until Oct. 1942.

These chattels were removed from 2013 W. 5th Ave. and sold at auction for the net sum of \$4.79 and this sum credited to the account of Mr. Fumio YAMAMOTO. However as he did not declare any property of any kind whatsoever, we are transferring the proceeds from sale of these chattels to the account of Mrs. YAMAMOTO.

LIFE  
INSURANCE:

Mrs. YAMAMOTO declared an insurance policy with the Monarch Life Insurance Co. in the sum of \$1000.00. This policy was not brought under the control of the Custodian.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.

The above summary is certified to be in accordance with the information on file.
