

Mineki TANABE died at Sandon, B. C. on April 25, 1943. According to information given on the R. C. M. P. form, the deceased was married and his wife, mother and father were all in Japan.

The deceased did not make a declaration to the Custodian and nothing is known of his assets.

On May 26, 1943, the B. C. Security Commission filed a claim for recovery of the sum of \$80.00 from the Estate of the deceased to cover the cost of his funeral. They were advised by this office on June 3, 1943, that the Custodian had no knowledge of assets belonging to the deceased.

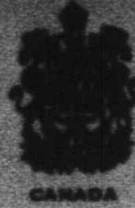
