No other information on file as to disposition of the Trunk.


Life Insurance:

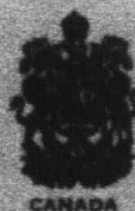
