PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY Fale No. 14710 July 17, 1946. Res Ichitaro KARIYA, Reg. No. 07013 This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on July 15, 1943. He was evacuated on September 10, 1942. In his declaration he reported a quantity of household effects and tools. Of these the cook-stove, stove-pipes and 6-gallon crock were discarded as valueless; the blind, sack of wool, kiddles cart, oilcloth table covers, and tools were not inventoried by Custodian representative, Matt Brown. The remainder of the goods reported were sold and the proceeds credited to the account of his wife, File 7323. The account of this man was credited with \$4.78 as income tax refund for 1941. This money was remitted on August 21, 1943, leaving no funds in his account. No other property is revealed by this file.
