
An amount of \$1.45 was credited to the account of the above Japanese person, representing funds standing to his credit in the Bank of Montreal at time he was interned, May 29, 1942. This small sum is being remitted to the above Japanese as per our requisition on file dated October 24, 1946.

Life Insurance:

This Japanese declared a \$2000.00 Mutual Life Assurance Co. Policy. (No. 350,319). This Policy was sent to the Custodian by the Commandant of Angler Internment Camp at Angler, Ontario, in his letter of August 5, 1942, and was held in safekeeping by this office until Mr. Takenaka was released from internment. The policy was then forwarded to Tomeo Takenaka in Montreal on June 23, 1943. No further reference is made on file to the above policy.
