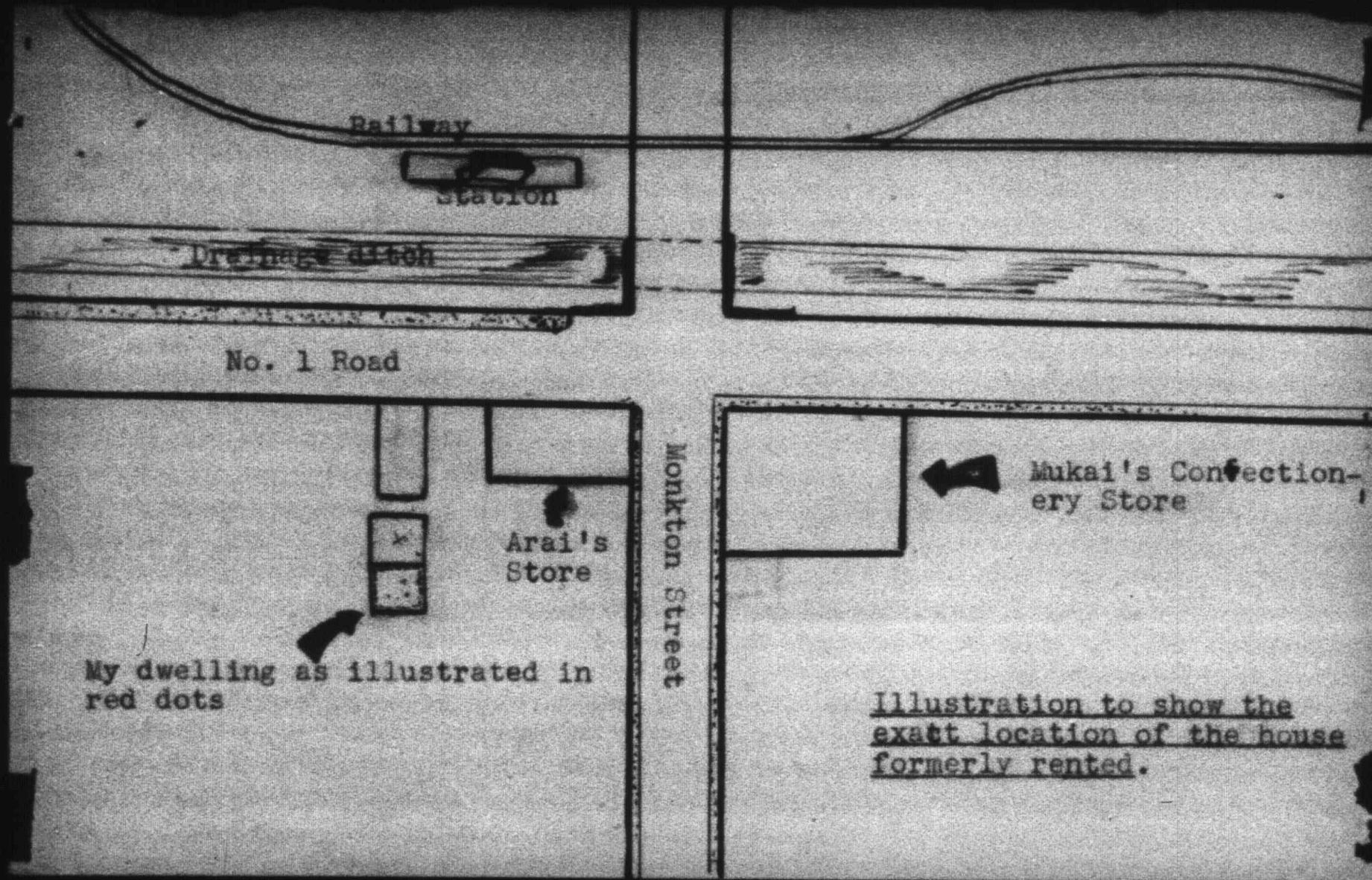

PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

CHATELS:

The above was evacuated on Feb. 23/42, and at the request of the Custodian he sent us a registration form duly completed dated July 12/42 on which he declared effects as shown on the J.P. form, some left in the house of Yoshitaro HASHIMOTO, File 12252, and some in the house of Iwao MIYASHITA, File 13928.

Chattels found in the house of Yoshitaro HASHIMOTO at 173 Moncton St., Steveston, were inventoried by Custodian on March 2/44 and removed to central storage in the name of HASHIMOTO. Nothing was found among these goods that could be identified as belonging to the above except a basket of fish lines and a box of hooks which were discarded as being of no value.

Regarding the goods declared as being left in the house of Iwao MIYASHITA, investigations reveal that this house was rented by MIYASHITA, File 6648, to a Mrs. Y. NISHI, File 4302. Our agent, Mr. G. M. Harris, reports on Aug. 31/44 that he personally inspected this house and found it in a terrible condition.

When the chattels found in this house were inventoried by the Custodian on Dec. 11/42 and removed to central storage, they were listed in the name of Y. NISHI, File 4302. Nothing was found among these goods that could be identified as belonging to the above. It is noted however that a cupboard attached to the wall and linoleum on the floor were left as fixtures and abandoned as of no value. These articles may have belonged to the above. No trace was found of any tools.

The file reveals the above owned no specified articles.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.

Re: YOSHIMASHI, Yoshio

The above lived in a house owned by Mrs. Imao Miyashita, (File no. 6648), near the corner of No. 1 Rd. and Moneton St., Steveston. The husband, on his J.P. form, declares:

1. A few chattels left in Yoshitaro Hashimoto's house at 54 Moneton St., (File 12252). The chattels were moved on March 2nd, 1944, and mostly sold at auction as per memo of June 10th, 1944, but there was nothing to identify any of them as belonging to the above.
2. A few articles were left in Mrs. Miyashita's house, (file 6648), in which he lived. The chattels in this house were in use by the tenant, Mrs. Gladys Daffoe, and were acknowledged by her on April 3rd, 1943 (see memo July 16th, 1943). Here again there is no way of identifying any of these goods as belonging to the above.
3. Image of Buddha, in Buddha's Temple.

The wife also declares chattels left in Mrs. Miyashita's house. Apart from 4 kitchen chairs, which were sold at our Steveston Auction #8, there is no way of identifying any of the effects as belonging to the above.

These houses are small and in very poor condition as noted on report of Mr. J. D. Mather of June 3rd, 1942.
