GENERAL SUMMARY

Mrs. BANDO was evacuated on May 23/42. On July 17/43 we sent her three copies of the J.P. form which we asked her to fill out and return. These were not returned by Mrs. BANDO.


Merritt Cartage, 934 Kingsway St., advised us that Mrs. BANDO had requested shipment of furniture left with them. We advised the company we had no objection to this shipment going forward but that they would have to make arrangements direct with Mrs. BANDO regarding storage and shipping charges. We advised Mrs. BANDO of this in our letter of Nov. 3/43, and asked her once more to fill out the J.P. forms, but she did not comply with our request. Again on Jan. 10/44 we sent her a new set of J.P. forms to fill out but she did not return these either.

There are no assets of any kind revealed in her file other than the goods Merritt Cartage advised us they had stored there. These we presume were shipped to her.

There are no claims on file against her.

The above summary is certified to be in accordance with the information on file.
