
Accounts Receivable:

We are going back to Japan on this 16th boat. From my friend I borrowed \$50.00 on September 1943 when my wife was ill. I was working at Nakusp logging all summer but this place have long winters that I borrowed \$300.00 on winters supporting family and with \$50.00 on September had \$350.00 total, but last summer I paid \$110.00 and still have \$240.00 left. I went to Commission yesterday and I begged to pay it but they won't so won't you please pay it to name Mr. Rokuro Daijo who now works at Rogers, B. C.
