Tokumatsu HIRANAKA died at Escondale, B. C. on December 11, 1944. He has no living relatives of which we have knowledge.

The deceased declared no assets to the Custodian and none are revealed on the file.

The only claim lodged against HIRANAKA is for the sum of \$67.20 made by the B. C. Security Commission to cover the cost of burial of the deceased. They were advised that the deceased had no assets from which to pay their claim.
