GENERAL SUMMARY

Re: Fumio NAKAHAMA, Reg.No.09681

This man was evacuated on March 31, 1942. On October 22, 1943 he declared to the Custodian that he owned no property in the protected area.

The R.C.M.P. reported, however, that a Kodak camera and case had been surrendered by him. This camera and case were handed to the B.C. Security Commission on May 4, 1943, for shipment to Fumio NAKAHAMA.

This file reveals no other property.
