On March 29th, 1943 you wrote us informing us that you had bought your washing machine from a man called Y. Muraki, who, at that time, was working for the Union Fish Co. and that the purchase price of the machine was \$129.50, of which you paid \$29.50 leaving a balance still owing to Muraki of \$100.00, and you stated that Y. Muraki had gone to Kelowna district.

Your washing machine has now been sold for \$135.00, but we are not sure who to pay the \$100.00 to, as we have two Y. MURAKIS registered with the Custodian. One is Yujiro MURAKI whose former address was 2020 Columbia Street, Vancouver, B. C., and his occupation according to his file was a labourer at some lumber mills. This man was evacuated to Lemon Creek, Slocan, B.C. but has died in the interval.

The other man who might be the party concerned is Yoshiro MURAKI who lived at 504 Alexander Street, Vancouver, B. C., and who was a salesman. His present address is Kelowna, B.C. His age now is 36.

Will you please inform us by return mail whether either of the two above men is the party to whom you owe the \$100.00. If you can give us the necessary information we will be glad to settle this account on your behalf, as we are now trying to get your affairs settled.

Please reply to this letter at your earliest opportunity.
