GENERAL SUMMARY

August 5, 1946.

Re: Kazuo KIDO, Reg. No. 08441

This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on August 31, 1943 in which he reported that he owned no property of any kind in the protected area. He had been interned on June 20, 1942 and released on July 6, 1943.

However, the R.C.M.P. handed to this office a Brunswick combination record player and radio. This was sold and the net proceeds of \$26.49 were credited to the account of this man. As we have received the receipt we are today remitting this amount to KIDO.

On July 31, 1943 we received two postal notes from the Commanding Officer of the camp at which this man had been interned. These postal notes in the amount of \$5.50 were sent to KIDO on August 16, 1943.
