Security Commission, Marine Building, Vancouver. If
you cannot secure these, a letter to the Security
Commission in Vancouver will be sufficient.

If the Security Commission see fit to
make shipment, they will contact us and we shall be
pleased to release the goods.

Dear Madam:-

On receipt of your letter of September 2nd, we made investigations at Steveston and received the following reply.

"As you know, Canadian Pacific House No. 2 was a community building placed at the disposal of various Japanese for temporary storage. When we moved these goods many articles were not tagged and we listed them according to the various piles as found in the house.

"On list No. 27 in the name of Keizo Mori I see listed 2 chesterfields and a dresser and as one Japanese was not likely to have 2 chesterfields perhaps one of these is the one in question. The same thing applies to stoves and heaters.

"Most likely the articles of the daughter-in-law are contained in some of the cartons.

"When a B. C. Security Commission release comes to hand asking for these articles I will endeavour to locate them."

On receipt of application forms filled up on the lines of our enclosed letter #107, we will see what we can do to arrange shipment.
