
Please note that the above Japanese has been repatriated to Japan. The following is the status of his account with this Department, covering the repatriation transactions:

GENERAL SUMMARY

This 61-year old Coal Miner, a Japanese-National, from Cumberland, N. C., was not registered with this office. He was single at date of evacuation (Mar. 15/42). He was repatriated to Japan on the 2nd August, 1946, per S.S. "General Naigoh".
