This woman and her husband signed a joint declaration to the Custodian on May 11, 1942, in which they declared 8 cases of chattels left at Hillcrest Lumber Co., Duncan, B.C. These are handled on the file of this woman's husband, File No. 8613, which shows these 8 cases were shipped at Mr. FUKAKUSA's request.

The Sun Life Assurance Co. of Canada notified us that this woman had a policy with that company. On November 21, 1944 we received the amount of \$8.14 from the Sun Life Assurance Co. being the cash surrender value of this policy. This was forwarded to Mrs. FUKAKUSA the following day.

The R.C.M.P. handed to this office a Philco Radio surrendered by this woman. This was sold and the net proceeds of \$17.39 were credited to the account of this woman's husband. As she surrendered the radio we are today transferring this amount to her account.
