GENERAL SUMMARY

File No. 15161

October 28, 1946.

Re: Hisao SHIMIZU, Reg. No. 11379

This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on October 7, 1943. He was evacuated on March 12, 1942.

In his declaration he reported ownership of two outboard engines: a Johnson 10 HP and a Bendix 2.5 H.P., and of a 15 foot boat.

The pleasure boat "Carefree" immobilized at Ocean Falls was sold by the Japanese Fishing Vessel Disposal Committee for the net sum of \$34.65, which was turned over to the Custodian.

The two outboard motors were seized by Naval Service and were turned over to the Custodian in April, 1943. These were sold by the Custodian, as shown in the Memorandum filed directly behind this Summary for the net sum of \$124.57.

Hisao SHIMIZU and Hideo NISHIMURA, File 1850, wrote the Custodian advising that the boat and engines were the joint property of the two of them; the net proceeds were therefore equally divided between them.

The \$79.76 credited to Hisao SHIMIZU from the boat and engines was remitted to him on December 15, 1943.

This file reveals no other property.
