This 40-year old Logger, a Japanese National, from Sinclair Mills, B. C., signed a Custodian "JP" declaration form on the 11th February, 1944. He was evacuated on the 16th March, 1942. He declared his wife and 2 children to be residing in Japan. This Evacuee was formerly known by the name of Saburo YAMAMOTO but now signs and is known as Yoshiharu TANIKAWA.
